******Please remember that end times for games are not exact. Students should contact parents as we leave the game to give an accurate time for pick up. Parents, please be prompt in picking up your child******

- **Uniform** – full uniform, blue t-shirt underneath
- **Uniform care** – you must wear your bibbers for the entire game. When not wearing your jacket and shako, they are to be neatly placed on the bleachers beside you, not wadded up in your band bag. The jacket and shako must be worn properly when in uniform. No variations will be allowed.
- **Before Call Time** – Do not load up on energy drinks and junk food. Also, I would prefer that students leave the school and return at call time. Please don't stay after school unless it is completely unavoidable. We will try snacks on the bus. If there's trash, privileges will be taken.
- **Jewelry** – No jewelry or hats. Class rings are permitted.
- **You Will Need** – instrument, music, flip folder, lyre, **money for concessions**
- **Carry On Luggage** – the only item you will be allowed to bring into the stands is your band bag (navy). If you do not have a band bag then you may bring **ONE BAG** that is similar in size. If your "stuff" doesn't fit in the bag then you're bringing too much to the game.
- **Third Quarter** – bring money for concessions at third quarter. **Food and drinks are not allowed in the band area.** Students must be in the stands ready to play the fight song when the third quarter clock reaches zero. Parents are not allowed to bring students food and drink in the band stands during 1st, 2nd, and 4th quarter. We will provide water during the game. 3rd quarter is for all other food and drink.
- **Conduct** – please read expectations in the band handbook. Students are expected to act like respectful young adults while with the band. Be mindful of your surroundings and what you say. We support the football team; however, we do not support or participate in acts of violence and belligerence. Negative yelling at players, coaches, referees, or fans will NOT be tolerated. Students who choose to be part of these acts will be immediately dismissed from the band program.
- **Bus Conduct** – please refer to the band handbook regarding bus behavior.
- **Chaperones** – are to be treated with respect at all times, under all circumstances! Disrespect towards any adult will result in suspension from the following game or dismissal from the program. Chaperones will be seated on the back row, the middle and the front of the buses.
- **Performing** – it is our job to give the best performance at all times! Mistakes will be made; we will fix them. Always be ready and always do your best!
